Sunday 9th January
Hedgelaying

Meet at Broxbourne Wood East car-park
Hedgelaying up in the north east corner of the wood, continuing work from previous years

Sunday 23rd January
Brickendon Pond task

Meet Brickendon Village Green car park
Coppicing willows on edge of pond, creating log piles and clearing scrub from pond edges.

Sunday 6th February

Work with the Wood Wardens

Have a go at Deer Basketing

Meet at Bencroft west car park 2-3.30pm
Opportunity for people to join in working with Wood Wardens to weave deer baskets.

Sunday 20th February
Hedgelaying pt 2

Meet Broxbourne Wood East car park
A final chance to hedgelay before the end of the season. There are some conifer to fell and timber to remove from the stream

Sunday 6th March
Lopping Lawsons

Meet at Broxbourne Wood East car-park
Planted as wind breaks around the conifer plantation areas, Lawsons Cypress is seeding and spreading unwanted through the woods. It's much easier to tackle them while they're small and can still be 'lopped'.

Care of young trees

Meet at Broxbourne Wood East car-park
Cleaning 15 year old oaks, pruning thinning around and removing tree guards

Sunday 3rd April
Broxbourne Wood Wardening

Meet Broxbourne Wood East car park
A range of jobs to be done around the car parks and sculpture trail to prepare the site for Easter holiday visitors

Sunday 17th April
Bencroft Wood Wardening

Meet Bencroft Wood East car park
Various wardening tasks around Bencroft Wood checking trails, steps and boardwalks
